24/263 RECORDING OF MEETING

Chairman requested anyone present to identify their intention to record the meeting.

24/264 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were given from Cllr Powling, Cllr Boylan and Cllr Greenleaf. Councillors voted to accept the apology and the reasons given. All in favour.

24/265 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Cllr Jenkins confirmed he is a trustee of the Mersea Island Community Association. Cllr Webster confirmed she is a volunteer at the MICA but not in a position of influence or power.

24/266 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

MOP 1 – Requested that the field behind the British Legion is cut for the annual New Years Day hockey games. Also asked who would be getting the Village Green 241 South signage, when the bathing rafts would be put out again, if the Coast Rd tank traps could be removed and that some breakwaters need repairs. Also, that on Wellhouse Hill there have been two accidents with water which may be caused by the run-off from the new Dawes Lane development.

MOP 2 – stated the earlier statement made by Cllr John Jowers in respect of the Village Green 241 South were incorrect with regard to the toilets and the fisherman's store, the land swap from West Mersea Yacht Club and the lease for that land.
