5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Tuesday 13 August. Further information about voting by post is available online www.colchester.gov.uk/elections/postalvote/
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Tuesday 20 August. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate
7. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Tuesday 20 August.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer a by 5 pm on Thursday 29 August.
